Warburtons in Wills in the 17th Century

Introduction

The purpose of this paper is to correlate all the information on Warburtons contained in the first 2 parts of the Bowdon and Hale Wills books, as a basis for further research to establish relationships between the various families.

The information available includes nine Warburton wills, wills of other family members, and references in other wills where Warburtons act as trustees, witnesses, debtors, or appraisers of inventories.

Warburton Wills

The Hale wills are up to 1680 only. Bowdon goes up to 1690, thou I have added the accounts and disputations of Thomas because it follows on from the previous 3.

- 1. William Warburton the Elder, Husbandman, died 1611 (Hale #9). William is referred to as William the elder. William was a noted 'banker' or lender of money, with over £190 owed to him on his death. No wife is mentioned. He inherited his 'leased' smallholding from his brother John. His children are John, Jane and Maude/Mathilda who seems to be illegitimate, and married Brian Coppock shortly afterwards. A Jane Warburton married her cousin Henry Warburton of Sinderland on 20th Feb 1615 in Bowdon, with John Warburton of Bowdon as bondsman (it could be this Jane). A William is overseer of the will, but his relationship isn't known. Son John proves the will and is presumably the John who is one of the appraisers. Debtors include a John Warburton and his mother Alice (probably William's nephew, John's son), a Robert Warburton, and a John Peake (a John Peake married Isobel Warburton of Bowdon on 1st Feb 1632). One of the appraisers is Richard Rogerson alias Johnson. He married Anne Warburton, widow 21st Aug 1917. Also it is believed Maude's mother is a Johnson girl and speculated that William may have later married her.
- 2. **Thomas Warburton, Yeoman, died 1635 (Hale #52).** This is just an inventory. Thomas was buried 14/1/1635. He leases land from William Duncalfe.
- 3. George Warburton, Yeoman, died 1639 (Hale #60). His children are, Sibill Eaton wife of John Eaton of Bowdon, yeoman, Jane Devis wife of William Devis of Bowdon, yeoman, Ann Hesketh wife of William Hesketh of inderland, yeoman, Margaret Leicester wife of Lawrence Leicester, gentleman, William, Ellen, and John. The last 2 are the major beneficiaries, along with wife Sibill. Witnesses are William Ashley, John Arstall, and John Goulden. A George Warburton is appraiser (presumably a different one). George was buried on 24/6/1639. The inventory includes land of John Duncalfe and John Burges (note Sibell's dispute with George mentions a George Burges). Son John owes £40.
- 4. John Warburton, Husbandman, died 1639 (Hale #61). This is a nuncupative will with some damage. Will mentions John, son, Jane, daughter, Joseph, reputed son, William, son, and John grandfather to Joseph. Also mentioned are Henry of Sinderland (who owes money), John Eaton (a benefactor, or maybe just owed money), and Thomas Perrin from whom he leased land called Aspinhurst. John and Jane are the maim benefactors, John is executor and Henry is an appraiser. John's wife was Jane Artenstall, now apparently dead. John was buried 8/5/1639. Note describes John Eaton as John's cousin Sibill's husband.

- 5. **John Warburton died 1672 (Hale #108).** This is John the wheelwright, and therefore possible son of William the elder (died 1611), though he must have been quite old since he was executor of his father's will. He mentions brother Henry, nephew Henry and kinswoman Alice. John is appraiser. In 1667 John had wife Katherine and sons John and William, but these appear to be dead by 1672. Brother Henry had wife May and second son Thomas alive in 1667, but not mentioned in the will. Nephew Henry married Elizabeth.
- 6. **John Warburton died 1679 (Hale #119).** This is part of an inventory. Candidates are a labourer living alone in 1667, or the son of John and Margaret (though this is disproved by mentions of John in his father's and brother Josiah's wills
- 7. Elizabeth Warburton, widow of Bowdon, died 1686(Bowdon #36). Bequests to sons George, Thomas, and William, grandson John (son of George, and daughters Sybill and Ann). William was executor but did nothing and had to renounce his role. Note says Elizabeth (nee Key) was widow of Peter. Marriage 12/5/1627, Peter dead by 1658, they farmed Pool Bank farm. Ann was married to Richard Clarke. Thomas was a wheelwright married to Mary (nee Aldcroft), with kids Aldcroft, Mary and Elizabeth.
- 8. **Sibill Warburton, spinster, died 1687 (Bowdon #37).** This is an inventory. Administration granted to Thomas and the Clarkes.
- 9. **George Warburton, of Bowdon, died 1688 (Bowdon #38).** This is an inventory, with John as appraiser.
- 10. Thomas Warburton, of Bowdon, died 1699 (Bowdon #42). These are accounts and disputations because Thomas (a wheelwright) died in considerable debt. He is the son of Elizabeth (note says brother William probably got the farm). Statement by Aldcroft gives his age at 23 years. There appears to be financial treachery by his administrator John Jackson.
