He was M. P. for Liverpool, 1589 and was admitted to Gray's Inn, February 26, 1588-9. He was High Sheriff of Cheshire in 1597 and towards the end of Queen Elizabeth's reign, was in the Irish Wars, where he was Knighted, 22nd July 1599 by Robert, Earl of Essex, lord lieutenant, Sir Edward was secretary and deputy to the Earl of Derby, who was the seneschal of King James in 1603, He married first Jane dau of
