Dear Joseph,

first I have to apologize myself to you for not to write to you for so long time, but it was very difficult to find out where your Grand Grand Father Dr. John Zenner came from, because the place of birth - Prussia - was in former times a very great region.

Your Grand Grand Father Dr. John Zenner was born September 02, 1844, in Groscampen, a little village near 100 km from here. His full name was Anton Konrad Johann Zenner (look at the duplicate of the birth certificate). His father Mathias Joseph Zenner was born January 04, 1822, in Losheim, a little village near 25 km from here. He married on February 28, 1842, in Losheim Barbara Thiel. He was a teacher and he teached in Groscampen. His wife Barbara Thiel died early on March 28, 1848, in Groscampen. The brother of John (= Anton Konrad Johann) Hubert, born 1847, died in young years in 1849. After the death of his wife Barbara Mathias Joseph came back to Losheim, where he married his second wife Helena Kremer in the year 1854. He hat two children with his second wife, but these children died very young in 1857 and 1858. Mathias Joseph Zenner died on October 08, 1857, in Losheim.

Anton Konrad Johann Zenner was in the age of 13 year's orphan and his brothers and sisters were also dead. I think, that the decision to emigrate to America, therefore was understandable.

The history of your family can be traced until ~ 1751. In this year a Philipp Zenner was born in Losheim and he was the Grand Grand Father of Dr. John Zenner. The profession of Philipp Zenner was farmer and shoemaker. I guess that this Philipp Zenner is also related to my ancestors.

With this letter I send the family tree of your family, so far as known, to you. I have the request for sending the particulars of your family and the family of your brothers and sisters to me, so that I can complete the history of the family Zenner.

The World Book of the Zenner family is published by the Halbert's Family Heritage, Inc., Bath Ohio 44210, USA, but the only good things in this book are the addresses from the Zenner families.

I hope that these information's about your ancestors are interesting for you and that I can hear from you again.

Has four children—John, Edward, Frank and Rosa Zenner. Came to Kansas in 1870, from Pittsburgh, Penn., located in Wabaunsee County, remained six years, engaged in the practice of medicine. In 1876, located at Wichita, and engaged in his practice there for three years. In 1879, located at St. Mark, Attica Township, where he now resides, and has a large practice. Was educated in Prussia, in the medical and military college, graduated in 1865. Came to the United States in 1867; has been engaged in the practice of medicine from that time. In 1879, established a drug store at St. Mark. The business has increased 100 per cent since its establishment. Is a member of the St. Mark Catholic Church. Is a Justice of the Peace.

JOHN ZENNER, M.D., was born in 1844 in Prussia, the son of Joseph and Barbara (Thiel) Zenner. In 1865 John graduated from the medical and military college in Prussia. He came to America in 1867. In the same year John married Christine Englert. To this union were born four children: John, Edward, Frank and Rosa. The family came to Kansas in 1870 from Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania. They located in Wabaunsee County, remaining six years, where John engaged in the practice of medicine. In 1876 the family moved to Wichita, where John practiced for three years. In 1879 they located at St. Mark, where John established a drug store, located at the present site of the St. Mark General Store. He was also a Justice of the Peace. Christine died in 1885 and is buried in St. Mark beside her son, John, Sr., moved to Colwich, where he later remarried.
